Ultrasound Technologist, Radiology

**PURPOSE OF POSITION:** To perform and provide clinical sonographic services to the people of the Bering Straits Region in accordance with NSHC's mission, philosophy, policies, and procedures while applying standards of the Radiology profession. Obtains and documents patient clinical information as needed. Participates in standby call. Performs basic patient care within the scope of practice and to departmental standards. Assists in the radiology department as needed.

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:** BLS certification required. Must have detailed knowledge of ultrasound physics as well as cross-sectional and vascular anatomy and Doppler techniques in order to perform independent procedures to Radiologist standards. Must be a graduate of an accredited ultrasound program(CAAHFP) with certificate and registry eligible. *Two* years of post graduate hospital clinical experience is preferred for UST I and *four* required for UST II and *six* for UST III.
