GUIDELINES

NOVEMBER 11, 2020- Until Further Notice

To prevent or slow the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), the City of Brevig Mission has established the following guidelines for our residents. These guidelines were recommended by the City of Brevig Mission.

Travel may be permitted upon approval by the City of Brevig Mission for the following: Individuals with family ties to the community, essential workers, medical appointments and/or emergencies and outside personnel for any community emergencies. Inter village travel will not be permitted at this time. (By air and sea)

Individuals will be mandated to provide documentation of negative test results 1-3 days prior to entering the community, Next will be met at the airport by city of Brevig Mission covid police to pick up the documentation to confirm who came in to quarantine. Once documentation is received the City will provide a letter to Bering Air, approving travel.

Non-residential workers will be required to quarantine in Nome, AK for 7 days prior to entering our community.

Individuals traveling for medical within the region, Norton Sound Health Corporation will verify the negative test results then approve patient travel. Once the City receives travel dates for patients, the City will provide a letter to Bering Air, approving travel.

Individuals arriving from outside the region will be required to quarantine for 7 days upon return to the community and will be required to test on the 7th day. The quarantine will end once there is documentation of a negative test result. Individuals will be required to test negative on the 14th day after your return to the community.

All household members, that have a quarantined individual in their home, are required to wear a cloth face covering in public.

All individuals are now required to use a cloth face covering in all public spaces.

No large gatherings of 50 people or more will be permitted in the community until further notice.

Residents are encouraged to maintain social distancing.

Residents that have symptoms of cough and fever of 100.4 or higher must call the Brevig Mission Clinic to make an appointment to be seen.
