

NSHC COMPETITIVE SCHOLARSHIP

NSHC AWARDS (5) \$5,000 PER TERM SCHOLARSHIPS TO QUALIFIED ALASKA NATIVES/NATIVE AMERICANS WHO MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Enrolled in a formal education or training program within the healthcare field
- Permanent Resident of the Bering Strait Region. Proof of residency, submit one (1) of the following:
 - State of Alaska ID card OR State of Alaska License OR Tribal ID/Enrollment (with current address)
- Applied to and meets the requirements of the NSHC MyCache Scholarship <https://my-cache.org>
- A Personal Statement

YOUR PERSONAL STATEMENT

Your Personal Statement, which is required for the Competitive and Doctorate Scholarships, should answer all the questions below and should not exceed 1 page:

- Why are you applying for the NSHC scholarship?
- How are you currently involved with the Native Community?
- What are your current and future educational goals and professional goals?
- How does your education meet your stated goals?
- How will your stated goals improve the health of Alaska Natives/American Indians?

NSHC EMPLOYEE SCHOLARSHIP

To provide financial aid to NSHC employees pursuing higher education This policy addresses program funding, outreach, eligibility criteria, application review and selection process, payment of continuing education, work requirements and continuing education, failure to successfully complete course work, CEU's, and continued status as an employee.

Continuing Education Scholarships are only available to regular, full time and part time employees of NSHC who have been employed by NSHC for a minimum of one year prior to applying for a scholarship, and remain employed through successful completion of all course work.

NSHC MAY AWARD A TBD AMOUNT TO QUALIFIED EMPLOYEES WHO MEET THESE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Employees must first receive approval from their department managers
- Courses selected must be relevant to the employee's position at NSHC
- Employees must complete an Employee Scholarship Application and submit the completed application to HR. Incomplete applications will not be considered

NSHC GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP

The NSHC scholarship program provides financial assistance to eligible students who are pursuing higher education in a health-related field. NSHC may fund students pursuing a non-medical-related degree if the degree will help further the vision and mission of the organization. Indian Health Service beneficiaries from the Bering Straits Region who commit to returning to the region and possible employment with NSHC, will have priority. Apply through the My-Cache website.

NSHC AWARDS A TBD AMOUNT TO QUALIFIED STUDENTS WHO SUBMIT AND MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Two letters of recommendation (cannot be from family)
- Official Transcript
- Current Resume
- Birth Certificate
- Student Number in writing from your Institution
- Your High School Diploma or GED
- Acceptance Letter from your institution

NSHC DOCTORATE HEALTHCARE CAREERS SCHOLARSHIP

This is a competitive scholarship for individuals that meet the requirements of NSHC MyCACHE Scholarship Program and are enrolled and studying in a healthcare related field with goals to become a Physician, Dentist, Optometrist, Pharmacist, Audiologist, or Physical Therapist for NSHC.

This scholarship is available for students studying to attain a Doctorate degree with the intent to fill the following positions at NSHC: Physician, Dentist, Pharmacist, Audiologist, Optometrist, or Physical Therapist at NSHC for a minimum of (3) years upon graduation .

NSHC AWARDS (3) \$10,000 PER TERM SCHOLARSHIPS TO QUALIFIED STUDENTS STUDYING TO ATTAIN A DOCTORATE DEGREE THAT SUBMIT AND MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Permanent Resident of the Bering Straight Region
- State of Alaska ID, License, OR Tribal ID/Enrollment (with current address)
- Applied and met all requirements of the General Scholarship
- Personal Statement
