<b>Brevig Mission</b>	3/23/2020	Y	N	City of Brevig Mission at (907) 642-3851	"Residents who have traveled outside of Brevig Mission MUST self-isolate for 14 days; if you violate this, Village Police Officer's will escort the individual(s) home."
<b>Elim</b>	3/25/2020	Y	N	Paul Nagaruk at (907) 880-1088 or Robert Keith at 890-2269	"There will be no passenger transportation in or out of the village until May 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2020." Medical travel, and all essential travelers, are allowed with out of region travel requiring a 14 day quarantine upon return to the village. See permit form.
<b>Gambell</b>	3/23/220	Y	N	City of Gambell at (907) 985-5112	Local residents may return home but they must quarantine themselves for 14 days and not visit any public places. Medical personnel from NSHC and ANMC are allowed to enter the city with proper identification and for medical reasons only. Non-Residents are not permitted in the city without express authorization from the City of Gambell.
<b>Golovin</b>	3/21/2020	Y	N They might implement a Nome Quarantine if they are traveling from a high risk area.	Charlie Brown at (907) 779-3211 or Irene Navarro at 779-3251	"All travel, including instate travel from Anchorage or Fairbanks, is now being recognized as high risk...Precautions should be taken on those that have recently travelled into Golovin from those areas..." Must call the Mayor for further instructions re quarantine requirements.
<b>Koyuk</b>	3/23/2020	Y	N	Morris Nassuk at (907) 412-3854 or City Office at 963-3441	"Residents are urged to limit unnecessary travel and only for Medical & Emergency Travel." "Quarantine 14 days in village. Take temp with thermometer 2 x daily to monitor for fever." Intervillage travel is prohibited. Please contact Morris Nassuk for requests about hunting and purchasing gas. They will not turn intervillage guests away if they are purchasing gas.
<b>Little Diomedede</b>	3/18/2020	Y	N Y for medical providers	City of Diomedede at (907) 686-2202	"All in-coming Diomedede people in Nome must be quarantined for 2 weeks upon arrival from mainland Nome or Wales." "No house to house visiting." Little Diomedede will refuse any passengers via helicopter services. People who are quarantined for 14 days in Diomedede cannot visit public work places.
<b>Saint Michael</b>	3/26/2020	Y	N	City: (907) 923-3222/2442 IRA: 923-2304/2405	"No air passenger transportation in and out... Unless emergent (i.e. medical, electrician, troopers, telephone, water and sewer) until May 1, 2020." They will be using the old clinic as a quarantine house. They are requiring a 14 day quarantine for anyone who arrives in St. Michael and all members in the house. Only one person in the house can run errands.

<b>Shaktoolik</b>	3/23/2020	Y	N	City of Shaktoolik at (907) 955-3441 or IRA 955-3701	"Residents shall be informed to restrict traveling between communities and large cities..." All travelers must quarantine 14 days upon arrival as well as their family members in the household.
<b>Savoonga</b>	3/23/2020	Y	Y – Travelers from Anchorage or beyond. N- Village to Nome will be able to quarantine in the village.	Myron Kingeekuk at (907) 984-2086	Shut down all domestic travel until threat subsides. Non-Residents quarantine prior and receive permission from Mayor. Community members traveling from ANC or beyond will need to self-isolate x 14 days upon return and monitor temp for fever twice / day if they cannot quarantine in Nome first. Gambell dental patients can go to Savoonga and wait in the clinic for their appointment, but must go back the same day.
<b>Shishmaref</b>	3/21/2020	Y		Karla Nayokpuk at (907) 649-2235 or at 649-3781.	On March 25 <sup>th</sup> , 2020 "individuals will be prohibited from entering Shishmaref for 30 days, which includes through air travel and inter-village snow machine travel."
<b>Stebbins</b>	3/25/2020	Y	N	City of Stebbins at (907) 934-3451 or the IRA 934-2393	On March 25 <sup>th</sup> , 2020 "...all non-medical air travel and inter-village travel will be prohibited from entering Stebbins for the next 30 days." All returning residents will be mandated to self-isolate for two weeks upon arriving into the community.
<b>Teller</b>	3/25/2020	Y	N They want travelers to quarantine in Nome then in Teller	City of Teller at (907) 642-3401 or Blanche Garnier (weekend #) 643-2295	Anyone entering the community/village of Teller via air or land must gain approval in writing from Acting Mayor, Blanche Garnie. If you have traveled out of the village, you must quarantine you and your household for 14 days at your place of residence. They must also take their temperature daily.
<b>Unalakleet</b>	3/25/2020	Y	N YES for medical providers	Roberta Cooper at (907) 310-1713	"There will be no airline passengers allowed within Unalakleet City Limits until May 1, 2020. Residents wishing to return home should do so immediately before the effective date and time with a mandatory two-week quarantine upon return. All household members of traveler must quarantine as well." Residents are not allowed back into the community while this ban is effective. Exceptions to the travel ban: "Essential medical travel and freight..." and "Patients who will need to travel in and out of UNK." If a person is traveling through Unalakleet, they do not need to call the City for permission to be there as long as they stay in designated the Airport.
<b>Wales</b>	3/25/2020	Y	N Mayor wants travelers to quarantine in Nome first then in Wales.	City Mayor Frank Oxereok Jr. (907) 664-2125 or 634-0337. Ellen Richards at Wales Native Corp 634-1006. Anna Oxerok at 664-3311	Resolution does not define non-essential or essential. States: "Essential travel, if possible, shall be postponed until the COVID-19 threat has subsided." Must have approval before arrival. Quarantine 14 days after travel. Non-essential is prohibited, but essential travel is allowed. The Mayor requests that all travelers get in contact with him, Ellen, and Anna before traveling.

<b>White Mountain</b>	3/23/2020	Y	N	City of White Mountain at (907) 638-3411	“Residents are urged to limit unnecessary travel; only essential travel will be accepted.” Residents will be mandated to self-isolate for two weeks upon return to the community and take their temperature every day. Nonresidents need approval.
<b>Nome</b>	3/26/2020	Y	Y	City Manager Glenn Steckman at (907) 433-6600 Or Clerk’s Office at 443-5345	All travelers who wish to leave or enter Nome via the airports must complete an Essential Air Travel Services Use Permit available at the City of Nome website ( <a href="http://www.nomealaska.org">www.nomealaska.org</a> ). You must submit this permit to <a href="mailto:travelpermit@nomealaska.org">travelpermit@nomealaska.org</a> , or you may fax it to the Clerk’s Office at (907) 443-5345. The quarantine plan (2 <sup>nd</sup> page) must also be filled out or it will be denied. Permit must be approved 72 hours before travel and it must be present at the airport. If you must leave and return, you need to isolate yourself for 14 days at home to reduce the risk of infecting your fellow community members.
